Holiday / Travel Vaccinations

If you're planning to travel outside the UK, you may need to be vaccinated against some of the serious diseases found in other parts of the world.

In the UK, the childhood vaccination programme protects you against a number of diseases such as tetanus, but it does not cover most of the infectious diseases that are found overseas.

General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Effective as of Friday 25th May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) is Europe's new framework for data protection laws and replaces the previous 1995 data protection regulations which the U.K's previous data protection law was based on.

The new legislation is designed to harmonise data privacy laws across the United Kingdom and Europe and brings outdated personal data rules and regulations up to speed within an increasingly digital era, as well as giving greater protection and rights to individuals. Within the GDPR there are large changes for the public as well as businesses and organisation that handle personal information.
